	Establish an internship program designed to assist members of the community in acquiring skills needed for broadcast employment.	KAKE-TV hosted 15 high school and college interns during the reporting period. Students typically spend about 15 hours a week for a semester working in the news, sports, promotions, or production departments. Most students receive academic credit from their school for their unpaid work. The interns assigned to the news department were supervised by the assistant news director or sports director. Their duties included shadowing reporters and assisting in the newsroom and on the assignment desk. Summer interns worked to create a summer newscast and social media pages. This year's interns were represented by the following schools: Cheney High School, Valley Center High School, Kansas State University, Friends University, Hutchinson Community College, University of Kansas, Oklahoma Baptist University, Cowley County Community College, Fort Hays State University, and Wichita State University.
2	Participate in events or programs relating to career opportunities in broadcasting, sponsored by educational institutions.	1 - On Dec. 3, 2015, Promotions Manager, Tim Boknecht, gave a tour of KAKE studios to students from Mulvane Middle School and spoke to the 22 students and 4 adults about careers in the different areas of broadcasting.  2 - On Dec.10, 2015, Promotions Manager, Tim Boknecht, gave a tour of KAKE studios to 18 students from Cheney High School's Journalism Class. After the tour students were given time to ask questions about careers in the broadcasting industry.
3	Sponsor events in the community designed to inform the public of employment opportunities in broadcasting.	KAKE produced the 7th annual Touch a Truck event on June 4, 2015 during the Wichita River Festival. On display were vehicles & employers from over 40 different companies including a microwave truck & weather chase vehicle from KAKE-TV.
